BCGFL FAQ's

Q. What do I need to do as the Home team?

A. Please ensure you confirm match details (Venue, KO Time etc.) with your opposition and ref (if appointed) no later than the Tuesday before the Saturday fixture.

Q. How do I postpone a game?

A. Please email fixtures@bcgfl.org.uk to postpone a fixture with as much time as possible. Note that teams are allowed two postponements a season that are not school event related, if school related, we will require name of school, nature of event and how many kids are affected.

Q. I can't play a weekend due to a Club Tournament?

A. Our seasons fixtures may run to the end of May, therefore if you know may be playing into May please don't book a tournament place for then as League Fixtures take precedence.

Q. I can't login into Full-Time?

A. There are a couple reasons this happens, either the info provided by your Clubs were wrong or when your login invite went out it went into the junk folder and hasn't been seen. If you require assistance contact secretary@bcgfl.org.uk.

Q. I'm not getting the Full-Time emails?

A. This is either because the email address is wrong or when setting up you didn't verify your email address, contact secretary@bcgfl.org.uk and a verification email can be sent back out, though check junk folder.

Q. I need something updating on my Whole Game profile?

A. We are unable to change anything on individual or Clubs Whole Game Systems, you'll need to contact your Club Sec or County FA to fix.

Q. Can you enter me into the County Cup? (Questions on County Cup)

A. Our League doesn't run the County Cup it's nothing to do with us, any questions will need to go to County FA who run it.

Q. What do I do post-match for the League?

A. You'll receive a text asking for your score, that's all we need, you can login to Full-Time to do this also where you can also submit a Ref Score if you were allocated one.

Q. There's a problem with one of my fixtures?

Q. Who do I contact regarding a disciplinary or welfare issue?

A. Any issues contact discipline@bcgfl.org.uk however most disciplinary issues now have to be dealt with by County FA and not the league.

Q. I'm not receiving the text to submit my score?

A. Contact secretary@bcgfl.org.uk to find out why but if there's no number associated to the contact then it's not something we can always add.

Q. I have a Referee related question?

A. For all Ref enquires please contact Natasha at berkshiregirlsrefallocation@gmail.com.

Q. What if I'm not allocated a Ref?

A. If you're not allocated a Ref then please see whether your Club can find one otherwise there's no reason another Coach or competent Parent can't ref the game to ensure it is played.

Q. How is the Ref paid?

A. Refs are paid for by the Home Team except in knockout Cup Fixtures where the fee is split between both teams.

Q. Where can I find the rules?

A. Rules can be found on our website, www.bcgfl.org.uk.

Q. Can you register my player please they're not showing?

A. Registrations tend to be looked at on a Friday evening, if then not showing still contact Tony at registration@bcgfl.org.uk.

Q. Where can get a team sheet?

A. Team sheets can be downloaded from Whole Game, you'll need to get your Club Sec to download.

Q. Do I need to put a postponement form in for games called off due to weather/pitch conditions?

A. No, just put on the group so John knows and can then rearrange.

Q. Can we play quarters instead of halves?

A. In competitive games no, please play halves. Development games at the younger age groups can be on the agreement of both Manager's though bear in mind there may be a game on after yours so ensure the timings work as more stops increase time on pitch usage.

Q. If a clash of kits who has to change or wear bibs?

A. The home team changes colours.

Q. What are the Ref Fees?

U8 - £15

U9/U10 - £20

U11/U12 - £25

U13-U16 - £30

U18 - £35

Q. How many subs can I have at a game?

A. 5 subs at a game. Subs are roll on roll off.

Q. What's the kick off time window?

A. Games can KO anytime between 9am and 1pm. However we recommend out of decency that if a club (home ground to home ground) has a travel time of more than 45 minutes that you don't put a 9am KO, but appreciate that it can be difficult to abide by that depending on facility availability.

Q. I'm still waiting for a response to my email/message?

We all have full time jobs not revolved around football so can't give instant responses a lot of the time.

Notes:

There is no goal difference within our league so it doesn't matter whether you win 12-0 or 1-0 it'll make no difference to the overall standings.

Power Play can be played. When a team goes 4 goes behind they can add an additional player, 6 goals behind then another additional player. Should the score cut down the 4 or 6 goal gap that player then comes off.
